What type of conditions / problems are suitable for this service

The defining feature of PodiatricRx is in musculoskeletal injury so this would include symptoms at a foot / ankle and knee level predominately.

The online consultations are suitable for the following;

- Anyone who needs a working diagnosis of their injury.
- An acute or long term musculoskeletal condition of the lower limb.
- Individuals that have struggled to get results with other treatments, or simply want to improve their health or performance

What to expect from video consultations

The online consultation will include;

- In depth history taking and expert assessment.
- Comprehensive observation of various functional tests and gait analysis where possible.
- Advice and guidance on appropriate treatment and management strategies, such as exercise programmes or footwear / sports footwear advice.
- Advice on treatment options and mechanical management plans.
- For follow up appointments this is an efficient way to stay in touch and to keep track of progress made and see if any alterations in the treatment plan are needed.

Once we have agreed that your condition is appropriate for an online consultation I will provide an overview of the key factors that will be needed during our consultation and you will receive this via email prior to confirming the date and time for the session so you can have everything in place.

Cost of Video Consultation Service

These sessions will be charged at a rate of £30.00 per 30 minutes and will need to be prepaid via a paypal link or BACS transfer.
